Furthermore, as a testimony to the resort's commitment to safety, Club Paradise Palawan has partnered with **Lysol**, global leader in health and hygiene products. In July 2020, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has approved Lysol as products that are proven effective against SARS-CoV-2 (The **virus** that causes a respiratory disease called **coronavirus** disease 19 (**COVID-19**). These Lysol products are also being used in all areas of resort.
